A. General terms and conditions

1. The award is open to cities and municipalities.

The "Lebendige Stadt" Foundation is looking for existing rail station environments with a design, a management concept and mobility connections that turn them into attractive and vibrant urban spaces. The focus is on ambience and amenities, safety, inclusive design of the surroundings and the bundling/integration of mobility services. Areas under the sole management of Deutsche Bahn AG are not eligible for the award.

The project should already have been implemented and should serve as a lighthouse project for other cities and municipalities.

- 2. The entry documents can be completed only on the website of the Foundation at www.lebendige-stadt.de/stiftungspreis2024. They may not exceed the defined scope.
- 3. The following documentation must be submitted online (please do not send anything by standard mail):
 - a. Fully completed entry documentation
 - b. Max. five visualisations/photos (incl. utilisation rights) that may be used for documentation and press activities
 - c. A graphic (aerial image) of the rail station environment showing the spatial demarcation to the rail station building and the other areas managed by Deutsche Bahn AG.
 - d. Before/After comparisons, where applicable and where available
- 4. The entries will be made available to the jury. The Foundation intends to compile a documentation of the competition and, to this extent, is entitled to publish the entries.

D. Jury decision and award presentation

- 1. The submitted projects will be reviewed in depth by the "Lebendige Stadt" Foundation and projects preselected for the jury. The best entries will then be presented in full to the independent jury.
- 2. An expert jury will meet once in the winter of 2023 to decide on the admission of entries and for the purpose of selecting the award winners.

- 3. In addition to presenting the Foundation Award including the prize money of € 15,000, the expert jury is also free to award certificates in special recognition of projects that were short-listed for the award. The jury must have plausible reasons for a possible decision to split the award.
- 4. The expert jury will provide reasons for its decision in a written vote. Apart from this, however, the jury will not provide any information; in other words, it will not make any statements either vis-à-vis the entrants or of a public nature regarding concepts that have not received awards. The decision of the jury is final.
- 5. The award ceremony will take place on **April 10, 2024** during our civic conference in Berlin. The award winners will be sent an invitation along with presentation instructions in good time.
