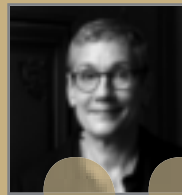

A comprehensive programme with top-class speakers and exciting discussions await you at the Humboldt Forum in Berlin.

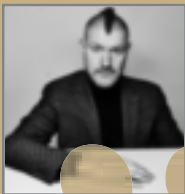
